

SACAS FAQs

- 1. How do I join SACAS?
 - a. Membership to SACAS is granted after you make the annual minimum donation to the Emerging Leaders Fund. Step by step instructions can be provided but here is the link to our website: http://sac.alumni.osu.edu/ Just hit donate!
- 2. How much is the minimum to join?
 - a. 1-5 years from graduation: \$15
 - b. 5+ years from graduation: \$25
- 3. How long does my membership last?
 - a. The calendar year, from January to December.
 - i. NOTE: This is NOT a calendar year from when you make the donation
- 4. What are the benefits of joining SACAS?
 - a. You will have the opportunity to connect with your fellow alumni of SAC, be offered chances to help the current members and initiatives of the organization, and stay connected to the Buckeye community by always being informed of Alumni Association events in your area.
- 5. Do I have to live in Columbus to be in SACAS?
 - a. Nope! SACAS will have opportunities for you no matter where life after graduation has taken you.
- 6. What are some of the things SACAS does?
 - a. We organize service and social events for our alumni in different areas across the country, offer a scholarship for a current SAC student to attend CASE ASAP National Convention, have a resume/Linkedin workshop, a mentor program to connect people with the same major or career interests, a host program to connect current students with SAC alumni living in the areas they will be traveling to, and much more!
